






2. What Key Stage(s) do you teach? 46 отговора











4. Which of these subjects do you teach regularly? (please select no more than 3 answers) 45 отговора




5. How often, on average, does your class participate in projects related to the environment? 46 отговора




6. How often do you run environmental campaigns in your school? 46 отговора




7. How often do you include environmental projects and lessons in your teaching? 46 отговора




8. When would you prefer to start an environmental project in your classroom? $_{\rm 46\ otrobopa}$




9. Which of the following are now implemented in your school? 46 отговора



10. Which of the following items do you recycle at your school this year? 45 отговора




11. How many separate recycle bins do you have in your school? 45 отговора





12. How familiar are you with the environmental distortions taking place in the world? $_{ m 46\ otroBopa}$




13. How well do you think the environment can recover on its own from problems caused by humans?




14. When people get involved in trying to solve environmental problems, how often do you think they make things better?




15. Should the government provide more money or less money to support the environment? 45 отговора
