The schools hall is usually used for celebrating festivals - Martini, Christmas, Easter. Other types of receptions are also held in the school hall – school meetings, welcoming quests, watching concerts or theatre performances. The hall is equipped with all the necessary communications.

## How Riga became

In ancient times, instead of Riga, there was a barn where people went to cultivate crops. One girl was very fun and cheerful and, going to the threshing, shouted: "Let's go, let's go girls! Let's go to the barn (rija), go to the barn (rija), and let's go to Riga!" As she put it "Riga", at that time Riga Castle, which had sunk, rose out of the water. Construction has started around the castle, and it has become Riga.



There is an undoubted reason for calling the Daugava a river of destiny - what happened on the banks of the river went hand in hand with the most important events in the history of its inhabitants. The name "Daugava" comes from the ancient Baltic words "a lot" and "water". As a waterway and a rich fishing place, the Great River has attracted many - both the Latvian old people, who along it created a dense population, and foreign conquerors. The Daugava was the border between the cultural and historical regions of Latvia - Vidzeme and Latgale on the right bank and Kurzeme, Zemgale on the left.
